Drus reimagines Scandinavian folk music by blending traditional song forms with cutting-edge digital innovation. Rooted in Swedish and Scandinavian folk traditions, their compositions incorporate elements of subdued EAM and contemporary art music, creating a sound that is both timeless and forward-thinking.

Using a 53-tone framework, Drus delves into the microtonal nuances of older folk melodies, adding new depth and complexity to their work. Acoustic instruments join custom digital tools when the duo crafts performances that bridge the past and future, offering audiences an immersive and transformative musical experience.
